PAINTS:

I prefer Winsor Newton Artists watercolors or DaVinci, but less expensive brands such as Utrecht or student grade, Cotman, etc. are fine.

Colors you will need:

Permanent Alizarin Crimson
Cadmium Red
New Gamboge
Turquoise
Aureolin or Cadmium Yellow Light
French Ultramarine Blue
Thalo Blue or Winsor Blue or Antwerp
Cobalt Blue
Thalo or Winsor Green

Other colors you may want to add:

Winsor Violet or Mauve or Cobalt
Yellow Ochre
Cerulean Blue
Winsor Red
Burnt Sienna

BRUSHES:

1 inch Aquarelle
Size 12 round sable or synthetic
Smaller size brushes (your preference)
Goliath size 20 or larger (optional)

PAPER:

D'Arches 140 lb. Cold Press – full sheets (22x30) can be cut to size
Or can buy blocks (size 12 x 16; 14 x 20; or 18 x 24)
Fabriano, Waterford and Lanaquarelle are good papers, too.

Masonite or ¼" thick plexiglass cut a few inches larger than your paper to support individual sheets of paper
masking tape
pencil and white eraser
paper towels or old towels, tissues
water container (Cool Whip size is good)
palette – one with a cover is best
